PHARMACY RESIDENCY
APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Please submit all materials required in PhORCAS. Applications submitted outside the PhORCAS system will not be accepted. We encourage applicants to customize their cover letter to our program. Applicants should expand on why they are interested in our program and what makes them a strong candidate.

The applicant should have 3 references complete the standardized reference template in PhORCAS. We recommend each applicant select at least two references who can comment on their clinical knowledge and/or work in a pharmacy setting.

Requirements for Applicants:

Applicants must be a graduate or a current student of an ACPE-accredited college of pharmacy. Applicants will have maintained a pharmacy GPA >3.0. Qualified candidates will need to be a licensed pharmacist (by August 1, 2016). Iowa licensure is *not* required. Applicants **must** be a U.S. citizen by the application deadline. Appointment is contingent upon satisfactory completion of a physical exam, including negative drug test. Applicants must meet requirements for federal employment.

This residency site agrees no person at this site will solicit, accept, or use any ranking related information from any applicant.

Application Deadline: January 6, 2016

Personal interviews with a 15-20 minute presentation are required. All applicants will be notified of their interview status no later than February 14, 2016.
