PGY2 Pain Management and Palliative Care Residency

Program Overview

The ASHP-accredited PGY2 Pain & Palliative Care Pharmacy Residency Program at the New Mexico VA Health Care System (NMVAHCS) provides residents with a rich and diverse, advanced training opportunity necessary to deliver comprehensive pain management, hospice and palliative care. The program is designed to equip residents with the skills and knowledge needed to be an essential member of interdisciplinary pain and/or palliative care teams.

This structured 12-month program includes direct and non-direct patient care experiences in a variety of both inpatient and outpatient practice settings. The residency includes training in pharmacologic and nonpharmacologic management of chronic non-malignant pain, malignant pain, acute pain, substance use disorders, and hospice and palliative medicine. There are opportunities for teaching and precepting students and PGY1 residents throughout the year. Upon completion of this comprehensive program, residents will be prepared to practice as well-rounded, independent clinical pharmacist practitioner in pain and/or palliative care.

FACILITY INFORMATION

The Raymond G. Murphy VA Medical Center is a Level 1 tertiary referral center with a 24-hour Emergency Room located in Albuquerque, New Mexico, the heart of the Land of Enchantment. As a teaching institution, the medical center is affiliated with the University of New Mexico and the Central New Mexico Community College. The medical center is authorized to operate a total of 310 beds, which includes 32 acute psychiatric beds, three different residential treatment programs, and Community-based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs) that operate in several locations throughout the state.

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Must be a United States citizen and have graduated from an American Council for Pharmaceutical Education-accredited College or School of Pharmacy and completed a PGY1 residency. Hired residents will need to provide documentation of a physical, hepatitis B vaccination, influenza vaccination, COVID vaccination and TB screening upon acceptance of the residency position. Applicants must participate in the ASHP Matching Service and the Pharmacy Online Residency Centralized Application Service (PhORCAS).
