Upload the following items to PhORCAS by the deadline (**January 6, 2017**):

- ✓ **Letter of Intent**
(specify dates available for interview)
- ✓ **Current Curriculum Vitae**
- ✓ **Official College of Pharmacy transcript**, along with transcripts of other colleges attended – forward all transcripts to PhORCAS as instructed on the website
- ✓ **Three recommendations**
Use the PhORCAS Standard Applicant Recommendation Request Form with a detailed recommendation. One recommendation should be from your PGY-1 residency program director.

Supplemental material: Upload as one document

- ✓ **Completed Pre-Training Assessment**
- ✓ **Documentation of United States Citizenship** (i.e. passport page, naturalization papers, or birth certificate)
- ✓ **Documentation of licensure in any state**

ABOUT THE MEDICAL CENTER

The Medical Center is located in the northern Bronx, on a suburban-like campus convenient to public transportation and highways.

The medical complex consists of a 230-bed acute care hospital, an 80-bed long-term care and rehabilitation facility, offers a home care program, and has a large ambulatory practice with 250,000 patient visits annually.

Manhattan is very close by, making it easy to enjoy all the cultural activities, nightlife, and the exciting pace that New York City has to offer. The Bronx Zoo, one of the top ten zoos in the world, and Yankee Stadium are only minutes away.

Throughout your residency you will participate in Community Living Center Interdisciplinary Team Meetings, Geriatric Clinic, Home-Based Primary Care, and Wound Care Rounds. You will also round with the medical team, evaluate patients, and have a significant impact on pharmacotherapy. We are a teaching hospital and therefore provide an opportunity to precept pharmacy students rotating with us.

Our excellent board-certified team of clinical pharmacy specialists have prescribing authority and are directly involved in patient care. Inpatient clinical pharmacists practice in the Critical Care, Acute Care, and Geriatric patient care centers. Clinical specialists are based in the PACT (Patient-Aligned Care Team), Anticoagulation, Diabetes, Renal, Geriatrics, Heart Failure, and Hepatitis C/HIV clinics. Electives to be arranged with RPD.
