- ✓ **Current C.V.**
- ✓ **Completed Pharmacy Practice Pre-Training Assessment**
- ✓ **Statement of United States citizenship**
- ✓ **Three letters of recommendation** on the ASHP Residency Applicant Recommendation Request Form and/or an equivalent detailed letter of recommendation, one should be from the PGY1 residency program director
- ✓ **Official copy of college of pharmacy transcript**, along with other transcripts of colleges attended
- ✓ **Specify dates available for interview**

All documents requested above should be received prior to scheduled interview date

Write your Resident Matching Program Code Number (*NMS application deadline is January 12, 2007*) on the face of **both** your C.V. **and** the Pharmacy Practice Residency Pre-Training Assessment. If your code is not yet available, write “code number pending” and provide a copy of your NMS Application Agreement
