

## **ABOUT CTVHCS:**

With the integration in 1995 of the Olin E. Teague Veterans' Center, the Waco VA Medical Center, the Thomas T. Connally VA Medical Center, and four outpatient clinics, these entities together became the Central Texas Veterans Health Care System (CTVHCS).

CTVHCS is one of the largest integrated healthcare systems in the Department of Veterans Affairs, and contains one of the newest VA hospitals, one of the largest inpatient psychiatric facilities, and one of the few Blind Rehabilitation Centers in the country. CTVHCS serves as the primary health care provider for more than 64,000 veterans in central Texas, logging over 730,000 outpatient visits. Affiliations include The University of Texas College of Pharmacy, Texas A&M University Medical School, and The University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston.

The Olin E. Teague Veterans' Center in Temple, TX is a full-service teaching hospital. It serves as the medical/surgical

referral center for CTVHCS across a 32-county service area. The state-of-the art Teague Center opened in 1998 and operates 167 medical/ surgical beds, 122 Nursing Home Care Unit beds, and a 10-bed hospice. Also on the grounds of the Teague Center is a 408-bed VA Domiciliary, a 160-bed State Veterans Home, and a new \$11.5 million dollar VA Research Institute. The Waco VA Medical Center in Waco, TX is a multi-VISN referral facility for chronically mentally ill patients and a national referral facility for blind rehabilitation. The Austin VA Outpatient Clinic is a 60,000 square foot facility serving a rapidly growing population of veterans surrounding the State Capitol. Community Based Outpatient Clinics are located in Marlin, Brownwood, Palestine, Bryan/College Station, and Cedar Park.

### **Program Overview:**

The residency provides a broad array of pharmacy practice areas, emphasizing primary care. Core block and longitudinal experiences are ambulatory care, internal medicine, and practice management. Electives include hematology/oncology, psychiatry, geriatrics, critical care, infectious disease, and research. Management training occurs within CTVHCS and with our onsite regional pharmacy benefit management group. Staffing is a component of general training with no additional nights or weekends required. Teaching opportunities include lectures, case conferences, and pharmacy student supervision.
