Our system serves veterans across a large geographical area in North Florida (33 counties) and South Georgia (19 counties). The medical center in Gainesville consists of a 250 bed acute care medical, surgical, and psychiatric service, a 40 bed geriatric care unit, and a complete ambulatory care service. In addition to our two medical centers in Gainesville and Lake City (45 acute care beds and a 230 bed long term care service), we offer a number of services to our patients in several satellite outpatient clinics and community-based outpatient clinics.

Program Description

This ASHP accredited specialized residency training program offers experience in the field of health-system pharmacy administration. The residency core rotations are spent with pharmacy leadership including the Chief of Pharmacy, departmental pharmacy chiefs, inpatient and outpatient pharmacy supervisors, and the clinical and educational program manager. Residents will learn and develop necessary skills by working with the pharmacy and facility leadership teams to prepare them to assume a leadership role upon completion of the program.
