THE JACC

The Joint Ambulatory Care Center (JACC) is a community based outpatient clinic of the VA Gulf Coast Veterans Health Care System. We are a new facility that just opened our doors in August 2008. We are located in Pensacola, Florida, adjacent to the Pensacola Naval Hospital. Annually, more than 150,000 outpatient visits are made to the JACC; serving over 24,000 veterans from Escambia, East Baldwin and West Santa Rosa Counties. We offer a variety of outpatient services including primary care, mental health, neurology, orthopedics, cardiology, pulmonary medicine, rheumatology, podiatry, urology, dermatology, hematology, nuclear medicine, radiology, ENT, audiology and speech pathology, ophthalmology/optometry, dental, physical medicine and rehab and ambulatory surgery.

PURPOSE

To prepare pharmacist clinicians for patient care positions or adjunct faculty positions at a college of pharmacy.

THE RESIDENCY PROGRAM

The residency program is a PGY-1 Pharmacy Practice residency focused in ambulatory care. It is a 12-month program consisting of longitudinal experiences in pharmacotherapy, lipid, anticoagulation, diabetes and smoking cessation clinic. The resident will also rotate through home based primary care and outpatient pharmacy, as well as an administrative and mental health rotation at the Biloxi facility.

Possible electives include:

- Additional experience in one of the required rotations
- Geriatrics/Community Living Center (CLC), Biloxi
- Hepatitis C Clinic, Biloxi
- Psychosocial Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Programs (PRRTP), Biloxi
- Acute Care - Medicine and Surgery, Biloxi

Additional requirements include:

- 3 journal club presentations
- 1 CME formal presentation
- 1 DUE or research project
- P&T presentation/proposal
- Preceptor development
- Attendance of various committee meetings
- Attendance of ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting
- Attendance of the Southeastern Residency Conference
