Thank you for your interest in the Pharmacy Residency Program (PGY1) at VA Eastern Kansas Health Care System. Our PGY-1 program currently offers (2) positions through the ASHP National Matching Service (program code 172413). All applications must be completed online via the Pharmacy Online Residency Centralized Application Service (PhORCAS) at: <u>http://www.ashp.org/phorcas</u>

Standard Requirements for an application in PhORCAS include: demographics, academic history, official College of Pharmacy transcripts, curriculum vitae, personal statement/letter of intent, extracurricular activities, and (3) letters of reference.

## Additional Requirements: United States citizenship

All application materials must be received on the PhORCAS system by January 5<sup>th</sup> to be considered for an interview. An onsite interview is considered an important part of the application process and is required for consideration. Residency candidates selected for interviews will have the opportunity to tour of the facility and interact with our residents and faculty. Interviews are typically scheduled in late January through the end of February. Interviews and final selections will be completed prior to the deadline for submission of rankings for the Match.
