



Bay Pines VA Healthcare System PGY-2 Health-System Administration and Leadership Pharmacy Residency

The Bay Pines VAHCS is a non-profit, teaching medical facility located on 337 acres and situated on the Gulf of Mexico. The healthcare system serves a 10 county area from Pinellas County in the north to Collier County in the south. Together, the Bay Pines VAHCS provides care to over 110,000 Veterans every year including our outpatient clinics in Bradenton, Lee County, Naples, Palm Harbor, Port Charlotte, St.

Petersburg, Sarasota, and Sebring. Our healthcare system serves the healthcare needs of America's Veterans in West Central and Southwest Coastal Florida by providing primary care, specialized care, and related medical and social support sources.

The PGY-2 residency program is accredited by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists. The PGY-2 Health-System Pharmacy Administration & Leadership residency at the Bay Pines VA Healthcare System builds on both Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and PGY-1 pharmacy residency program experiences to contribute to the further development of the resident as a clinical pharmacist and future pharmacy leader. This PGY-2 residency provides the resident with opportunities to function independently as a practitioner and pharmacy leader. The resident will integrate accumulated experience and knowledge and incorporate both into the provision of patient care. Residents who successfully complete this PGY-2 program will possess competencies that qualify them for a clinical pharmacist role as well as the attributes that prepare them to become a pharmacy administrator and future leader.

Application Requirements

- Application due date: 01/02/2023
- The applicant must possess a Doctor of Pharmacy Degree (Pharm.D.) from an ACPE accredited college
- U.S. citizenship is required
- The applicant must be registered with the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists' Match Program
- The applicant must have successfully completed a PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency from an ASHP accredited program prior to start of PGY-2
- An interview is required for all invited applicants
- Complete online application through PhORCAS

 - Personal/Letter of Intent
