This PGY1 Pharmacy Residency incorporates a patient aligned care team (PACT) approach. Clinical pharmacists manage and act as mid-level providers for disease states including anticoagulation, diabetes, hypertension, and dyslipidemia as part of a healthcare team.

Residents gain hands-on experience with management of these disease states and by staffing our on-site outpatient pharmacy.

A competitive yearly stipend is earned in addition to vacation days and sick leave. Healthcare benefits are also available.

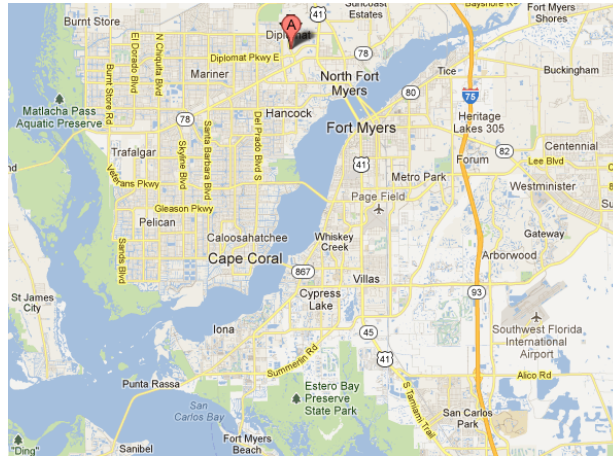

Busch Gardens Amusement Park – Tampa is only a 2 hour drive away

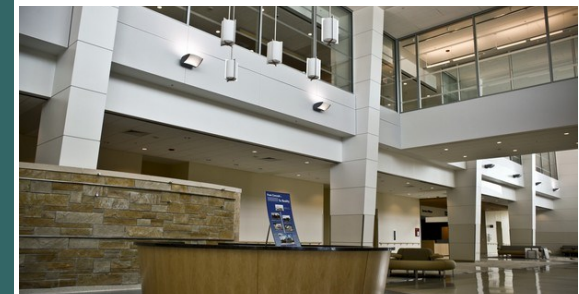

Requirements

- The applicant must possess a Doctor of Pharmacy Degree (Pharm.D.) from an ACPE-accredited college.
- All residents will be required to successfully complete a state board examination. Licensure may be through any U.S. State Board of Pharmacy.
- It is preferred that Board Examination is complete prior to starting the residency, however there is some flexibility. You *must* be licensed by September.
- U.S. citizenship is required.
- The applicant must be registered with the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists' Matching Program.
- Application Deadline: **January 7, 2019**
- An on-site interview is required for all applicants.
- Minimum GPA: 3.0
- Once selected, the resident must attend a one to two week orientation at Bay Pines VA Healthcare Center near St. Petersburg, Florida.
- Once selected, applicant must become a member of ASHP and attend Midyear.

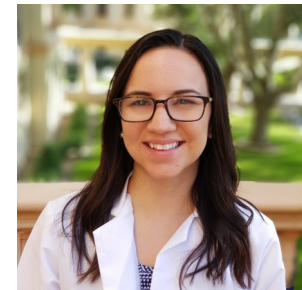
