Program

Our residency is a 12 month, full-time program that provides two residents an intensive experience in delivering comprehensive pharmaceutical care—with expanded offerings on mental health services—to the Veteran population in South Texas. The residents will complete their training at Corpus Christi VA Outpatient Clinic and Corpus Christi Specialty Clinic, which are located near each other in Corpus Christi, Texas.

Purpose

The purpose of the residency program is build on PharmD education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacist responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions. After completion residents will be eligible for board certification and postgraduate year two pharmacy residency training.

- Medication Therapy Management clinics provide residents the opportunity to independently initiate, adjust, and monitor patient drug regimens
- Longitudinal rotations allow residents to recognize the benefits of continuity of care, assess effectiveness of previous interventions, and achieve increasing independence
- Teaching and presentations including clinical in-services, case presentations, journal clubs, and patient education sessions utilize both in person and online media platforms, promoting well rounded presentation skills
