The Jonathan M Wainwright Memorial VA Medical Center PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency is a 12-month program designed to build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Residents will work alongside clinical pharmacy specialists with prescriptive authority during 4-to-6 week rotational experiences.

Did you know?

The Jonathan M Wainwright VA Medical Center is comprised of the VA facility in Walla Walla, WA, located on an **88-acre campus and serving approximately 18,000 Veterans.** Veterans are also seen at **four community-based outpatient clinics (CBOC)** and **two primary care-telehealth outpatient clinics.**

Applicant Requirements

- United States Citizen
- Graduate of an ACPE accredited School of Pharmacy
- Be able to obtain pharmacist state licensure within 90 days of start date

- Curriculum vitae
- Official pharmacy school transcript
- Three letters of recommendation
